4.	<p>Building Control Partnership with South Kesteven District Council</p> <p><b>Key Decision*</b></p>	<p>RESOLVED that Cabinet:</p> <p>a) accept South Kesteven District Council being the lead authority for the delivery of Building Control services for the joint authorities in partnership with Rushcliffe Borough Council in accordance with the terms set out in the report and;</p> <p>b) delegate authority to the Executive Manager - Communities in consultation with the Portfolio Holder for Sustainability, to enter into the legal agreement setting out the terms of the partnership shared service with South Kesteven District Council prior to the commencement of the partnership arrangement on 1 April 2014.</p>

Civic Centre Options	<p>RESOLVED that Cabinet</p> <p>a) continues to support the process, resource input and required work to develop the Council's business case for a relocation from the Civic Centre site to the proposed redeveloped Rushcliffe Arena site;</p> <p>b) sets up a Member Group, chaired by the Leader of the Council in line with the agreed Terms of Reference, to consider issues arising from the proposed redevelopment of the Arena site and the potential relocation from the Civic Centre; and</p> <p>c) refers the following issues to the Member Group requiring that their recommendations be reported to Cabinet at its meeting on 13 May 2014;</p> <p>i) to consider the report of the Chief Executive on the potential future of the Civic Centre and the Council's role in such developments.</p> <p>ii) to consider the potential options for the Arena development including the appraisal of potential facilities.</p>
