5	Provision of Taxi Ranks in West Bridgford	<ul> <li>RESOLVED that pursuant to Section 63 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976 Cabinet approve:</li> <li>a) an increase to the hours of use of the existing rank on Bridgford Road to 24 hours for four spaces whilst keeping a 1900 to 0700 hour restriction on the remaining two spaces, and;</li> <li>b) create an additional evening rank between the hours of 1900 and 0700 capable of accommodating six vehicles in the layby on Central Avenue, nearest to the junction with Tudor Square.</li> </ul>
6	Revision Of Policy Regarding The Relevance Of Previous Convictions	RESOLVED that the revised policy regarding the relevance of previous convictions is endorsed for submission to full Council for approval.
7	Financial Outturn 2011-12	<ul> <li>Cabinet RESOLVED that:</li> <li>a) the financial outturn for 2011-12 be noted;</li> <li>b) the principle that any underspend be used to maintain the level of earmarked reserves before increasing general fund balance, be approved;</li> <li>c) the capital carry forwards be approved;</li> <li>d) the proposed changes to the Council's earmarked reserves be approved.</li> </ul>
