Community Governance Review Edwalton – Final Recommendation	<ul> <li>RESOLVED that Cabinet:</li> <li>a) accept the results of Stage 2 of the consultation, which, following Stage 1 of the consultation, asked residents of Edwalton Village Ward to vote on the recommendation of the Member Group <b>not</b> to establish a parish council in Edwalton</li> <li>b) endorse the recommendation of the Community Governance Review Member Group <b>not</b> to establish a parish council in Edwalton, and forwarded to Council for approval.</li> </ul>

Community Governance Review Shelford and Newton – Draft Proposals for Further Consultation	<ul> <li>RESOLVED that Cabinet</li> <li>a) Endorse the recommendation of the Community Governance Review Member Group to establish separate parish councils for Shelford and Newton; and</li> <li>b) confirm its support for the arrangements for the second stage of the consultation.</li> </ul>
6.	2014/15 Budget and Financial Strategy	<ul> <li>RESOLVED that Cabinet recommends to Council:</li> <li>a) the budget setting report and associated financial strategies 2014/15 to 2018/19 (attached Annex) including a Transformation Strategy to deliver efficiencies over the five year period (Appendix 3).</li> <li>b) the Capital Programme as set out in Appendix 4.</li> <li>c) Rushcliffe's 2014/15 Council Tax for a Band D property is set at £117.99 (no increase from 2013/14).</li> <li>d) the Special Expenses for West Bridgford, Ruddington and Keyworth (as set out in Appendix 1) resulting in the following Band D Council tax levels for the Special Expense Areas: <ul> <li>i) West Bridgford £54.41 (£54.68 in 2013/14)</li> <li>ii) Keyworth £1.46 (£1.47 in 2013/14)</li> <li>iii) Ruddington £3.55 (£2.21 in 2013/14)</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
